

MINUTES OF MEETING OF WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION IN COLUMBIA
FEBRUARY 24, 1959

Present were Chairman Warren, Commissioners Cantey, Cox, Oliphant and Johnson, Director Richardson, Mr. Webb, Mr. Schley, Mr. Fuller and Dr. Lunz.

Director Richardson brought up a request from the Berkeley and Clarendon delegations for the purchase of two rescue boats from Santee-Cooper funds, the boats to be operated by the sheriffs' offices. He said that the Attorney General had ruled game money could not be spent for this purpose. Director Richardson was requested to inform the delegations of the ruling of the Attorney General.

The appointment of George Early as a Calhoun warden was approved.

The question of the reappointment of Warden Otis Parsons of Georgetown was referred to Mr. Huggins.

After a brief discussion of the proposed recommendations in regard to the commercial fisheries laws, the Commission attended a joint meeting of the Senate Fish, Game and Forestry Committee and the House Agriculture and Conservation Committee. Chairman Warren presented the committees with copies of the special sub-committee report and discussed some of the major points of the recommendations, stating that the Commission and Department personnel would be glad to provide any further information that was required.
