SPECIAL MEETING

SOUTH CAROLINA WILDLIFE AND MARINE RESOURCES COMMISSION

JULY 7, 1972

COLUMBIA, SOUTH CAROLINA

A special meeting of the Wildlife Resources Commission was held in the Commission Room on Friday, July 7, 1972. Chairman Eltzroth presided and welcomed two new Commission Members - Mr. J. W. Hudson of Spartanburg and Dr. Robert L. Lumpkin of Georgetown. He also noted that Senator Rembert Dennis and Representative Carlyle Goodman are new members but were not able to attend this meeting. Also in attendance at this meeting were Major Cantey, Executive Director Webb, Pat Ryan, Gene Howell, Brock Conrad along with Commissioners Thompson, Williams and Rhame.

Chairman Eltzroth explained that this meeting had been called for the purpose of setting the dove season and the marsh hen season.

After careful deliberation, the Commission adopted the following open season dates as follows:

Mourning Doves: From Sept. 2 to Sept. 30
 From Nov. 18 to Dec. 2
 From Dec. 19 to Jan. 13

Rails (King, Clapper, Sora, and
Virginia): From Nov. 4 to Jan. 12

Woodcock: From Dec. 26 to Feb. 28

Common Snipe (Wilson's):
 From Dec. 26 to Feb. 28

Gallinules: From Nov. 4 to Jan. 12

A copy of the above seasons was sent to the Director of the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife in Washington, D. C. and a copy is attached to these Minutes and made a part hereof.

A brief Executive Session followed and the Commission adjourned at 4:50 P. M.
