Travel 1.4 miles and turn left onto SC 28 E. Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Parsons Mountain Road. Travel 1.5 miles and turn right onto Campground Road. Travel 1.2 miles to the access area. |

Turn right onto Center Street. Travel 0.3 miles and turn right onto W Railroad Avenue. Parking area will be on your right. |

Take a slight right onto US 178 W. Continue on 178 for approximately 2 miles and turn right onto Manse Jolly Road. Take the first right and enter Darwin H. Wright Park. |

The entrance to the park will be approximately 0.7 miles on your left. |

Travel 1.5 miles and turn left to stay on Milford Road (State Road S-4-236). Travel over Old Dobbins Bridge Road onto Andersonville Road for about 2 miles to the Weldon Island Recreation Area sign on your right. |

Travel approximately 9 miles and turn left onto Sharper Drive. Travel 1 mile and turn right onto Bargain Drive. Travel 0.8 miles and turn left onto Spiers Landing Road (S-8-536). Deadends at park. |
| Fred L. Day Fishing Pier | Berkeley | Lake Moultrie | Pier | Wood | N | N | N | N | 50 | Dirt | From Cross, take SC Hwy 6 E. Travel 3 miles and turn left onto Boating Landing Way. Road ends at access area. |

Turn left into the Goose Creek Municipal Complex. Pond access is located directly behind the buildings. |

Travel 1.1 miles and turn left onto the access road to the pond. |

Travel 3.6 miles and the pond will be on your right. |

Travel 3.2 miles and turn left onto State Road S-8-35. Travel 0.9 miles and take a slight right to enter the parking area. |
| Canal WMA Public Dove Field (Hwy 45-North of Canal) | Berkeley | Rediversion Canal | Bank | NA | N | N | N | N | Limited | Gravel | From St. Stephen, travel on SC 45 W/Ravenel Street towards Pinewood. Travel 1.1 miles and the access area will be on your right on both sides of the bridge. |
| Canal WMA Public Dove Field (Hwy 45-South of Canal) | Berkeley | Rediversion Canal | Bank | NA | N | N | N | N | Limited | Gravel | From St. Stephen, travel on SC 45 W/Ravenel Street towards Pinewood. Travel 1.1 miles and the access area will be on your right on both sides of the bridge. |

At the stop sign, continue straight and turn left to stay on Sarratt. Continue to follow Sarratt down to the river. |

Travel 1 mile and turn left onto Ford Road (State Road S-11-50). Travel 0.3 miles and turn left onto Wolf Den Lane. This road goes to the river. |

The fishing pier is past the Bowens River Canoe Launch on the left. There is also bank access between the canoe launch and the pier. |

Travel 0.1 mile and turn right onto Old McKown Farm Road. Access will be approximately 400 feet ahead on your left. |
